

# Small Bowel Enteroclysis Studies

Ask RA or Radiologist before mixing solution

## POSITIVE (used for obstruction and mass)

Supplies:

- Maglente Catheter
- Xylocaine jelly
- Antitopical spray
- Hemostats
- Enteroclysis Bag
- Enteroclysis Pump
- Tape for NJ tube
- 60mL syringe
- Isovue 300

- Fill entero bag with 100mL of Isovue 300, and add warm water to make 2 liters of fluid.  
Shake well
- Take scout KUB
- IV needs to be started **before** procedure begins.
- Glucagon will be given in CT. Ask regarding dose, but typically it is .25mL
- Reglan may be given as well, ask RA or Radiologist.
- Stop pump when transporting to CT

## NEGATIVE (Inflammatory Bowel Disease)

Supplies:

- Same as above except **NO** Isovue 300, no contrast is used for this type of entero.  
Fill bag to 2400mL of warm water

- Take scout KUB
- IV needs to be started **before** procedure begins.
- Glucagon will be given in CT. Ask regarding dose, but typically it is .25mL
- Reglan may be given as well, ask RA or Radiologist.
- Stop pump when transporting to CT
